Name of the post : **Assistant Professor (Vyakaran)**

Qualifications and General Instructions

1. Acharya/Master's Degree (Parmparik Vyakran) with 55% marks, Master's Degree in education 55% marks with (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent.
2. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC.GSLET (Gujarat State Lecturer Eligibility Test) / GSET (Gujarat State Eligibility Test) Score shall be valid for appointment in the University.
3. Not with standing anything contained in UGC Regulations in its sub-clauses (i) and (ii) to the Clause 4.4.1, candidates, who are or have been awarded the Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standard and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations-2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions. *Provided*, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. program prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/By-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions: -
 - a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
 - b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
 - c) An open Ph.D. Viva Voice of the candidate has been conducted;
 - d) The Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a referred journal;
 - e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D. work in conferences /Seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC / ICSSR/ CSIR or any similar agency. *The fulfilment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.*

OR

B. The Ph.D. degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following:

(i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) (ii) the Times Higher Education (THE) or (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

4. Ability to teach through the medium of Sanskrit is must.
5. A relaxation of 5% may be provided at the Graduate and Master's level for the Scheduled Caste /Scheduled Tribes/Differently Abled (Physically and Visually differently abled)/Other Backward Classes (OBC/SEBC) (Non-Creamy layer) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic records during different recruitment to teaching positions. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a scale wherever grading system is followed) and **the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace marks.**
6. The minimum qualifications for the Posts of Assistant Professor are as expressed by the UGC Gazettes, Notifications and G.R. of Govt. of Gujarat, Shree Somnath Sanskrit University rules and subsequent amendments made therein.
7. NET/SLET/SET shall not be required for such Master's Degree programs in discipline for which NET/SLET/SET accredited test is not conducted.
8. **In case of the Hon'ble Court matter, the judgement of the Hon'ble Court shall be final and shall binding for the candidate/s appointed on the post.**
9. A relaxation of 5% marks may be provided from 55% to 50% marks to the Ph.D. degree holder who have obtained their degree prior to 19th September, 1991 for all those positions governed by the UGC regulations.

11. Candidates applying for the post of an Assistant Professor have to fill in required information in the prescribed application form along with research & academic contributions with supporting documents, certificates etc. Application form can be downloaded from the website – www.sbtbedcollege.org It is compulsory to submit the hard copy (**IN TWO COPIES**) of an application form without which the application shall not be considered. Out of Three Copies, one copy shall be original, and other two copies can be its photocopies/Xerox.
12. If the space against any item is insufficient, separate sheet may be used.
13. The applicant should ensure that the application is submitted to the **Registered Post A.D. OR Speed Post only** so as to reach to, **IC Principal, Shri Bhagwat Vidhyapith Shiksha Shastri (B.Ed.) College, Bhagwat Vidhyapith, Krishna Dham, Sola, S.G. Highway, Ahmedabad- 382481** before the due date.
14. Candidate if invited for an interview will have to attend at his/her own expense. No TA/DA shall be paid.
15. The period of time taken by the candidates to acquire M.Phil. and/or Ph.D. shall not be considered

As Teaching/Research Experience to be claimed for the appointment to the teaching positions. However, the period of active services spenton pursuing Research Degree i.e. for acquiring Ph.D. degree simultaneously without taking any kind of leave may be counted as teaching experience for the purpose of direct recruitment/promotion to the post of Associate Professor and above.”

16. Candidates must enclose the attested or self-attested copies of all Certificates, Mark sheets, Documents, Testimonials, etc.
17. Canvassing in any form on behalf of or by any candidate will disqualify him/her from being considered.
18. Criteria for short listing of candidate for interview for the post of Assistant Professor shall be governed by the UGC Gazette-2018 as specified in Appendix-II Table 3 and Table 3 B of pp-107-109. The Academic/Research Score as specified in Appendix II (Table 3A) for universities, and Appendix II (Table 3B) for colleges, shall be considered for short-listing of the candidates for interview only.

Note: The Academic score as specified in Appendix II (Table 3A) for universities, and Appendix II (Table 3B) for colleges shall be considered for short-listing of the candidates for interview only, and the selections shall be based only on the performance in the interview.

19. For short-listing of candidates for interview for the post of Assistant Professor, the University shall call twenty (20) candidates against one (1) each post of Assistant Professor in the respective subject on the basis of the UGC Gazette, 2018, Appendix II, Table 3A, and Table 3B from the top merit.
20. Experience and qualifications will be reckoned as on the last date for submission of applications. No updating of qualifications and experience will be entertained after the last date of the submission of applications. The applicant must ensure that he/she fulfils the eligibility conditions for the post.
21. The candidates applying for the post of Assistant Professor must enter the relevant Academic/Research Score (A/R Score) in the space provided against the given categories in each of the Column, and it must be supported by documentary evidence, without which no claim on account of Academic / Research Score would be entertained.
22. The candidates applying for the posts of Professor/Associate Professor shall necessarily submit Self-Attested One Copy of Top Ten Research Papers for the Post of Professor/Top Seven Research Papers for the Post of Associate Professor respectively, along with his or her applications.
23. The candidate shall enclose Self-Attested Copies of Certificates towards the evidence of Age, Educational Qualifications, Caste, Physical Disability, Experience, etc. with his or her applications without fail.

24. A relaxation of 5% shall be allowed at the Bachelor's as well as at the Master's level for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Socially and Economically backward Class (SEBC)(Non-Creamy Layer)/Differently-abled ((a) blindness and Low Vision; (b) Deaf and Hard of Hearing;(c) Locomotors Disability including Cerebral Palsy, Leprosy Cured, dwarfism, Acid-Attack victims and Muscular Dystrophy; (d) Autism, Intellectual Disability, specific learning disability and mental illness;(e) multiple disabilities from amongst persons under (a) to (d) including Deaf-Blindness) for the purpose of eligibility and assessing Good academic record for direct recruitment. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, **based only on the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedure.**
25. Applicants awarded degrees by Foreign Universities shall be required to submit Equivalence Certificate issued by Association of Indian universities, New Delhi. The University reserves the right to require Equivalence Certificate for various degrees from any of the applicants.
26. Reservation for SC/ST/SEBC/EWS and Persons with Benchmark Disabilities will be as per existing policy of Government of Gujarat and shall be applicable to Gujarat domicile candidates only.
27. Candidates seeking reservation under scheduled caste (SC)/scheduled tribe (ST) Category are required to submit Certificate on the format prescribed by the Government of Gujarat.
28. Candidates seeking reservation under socially and economically Backward Class Category are required to submit Certificate on the format prescribed by the Government of Gujarat.
29. Candidates applying for the post(s) reserved for socially and economically backward class (SEBC) should submit a self-attested Copy of valid caste certificate specifically mentioning Creamy Layer-Exclusion in the format prescribed by Government of Gujarat.
30. Economically weaker sections (EWS) vacancies are tentative and subject of the directives of Government of Gujarat and outcome of any litigation. Candidates applying for the post(s) reserved for EWS Category have to submit certificates for eligibility for reservation in favor of EWS in the format as prescribed by social justice and empowerment department, Government of Gujarat's Resolution No: EWS/122019/45903/A, Date:25/01/2019 (In English)
31. The prescribed qualifications and experience are minimum and the mere fact that a candidate possesses the same will not entitle him/her for being called for personal interview.
32. For the post of Professor/Associate Professor/Assistant Professor, each candidate may be asked to offer a Seminar before the personal interview in front of Selection Committee. The Seminar presentation will be for a maximum of **15** minutes on the topic of candidate's choice in the subject concerned.
33. Appointed teachers may be assigned other academic or administrative responsibilities in addition to their regular teaching and research.

34. The word “experience” may include the experience as a temporary lecturer/temporary assistant professor / temporary teaching assistant / temporary research assistant / Mahavidyalaya teaching assistant / Mahavidyalaya pradhyaapak / Mahavidhyalaya adhyapak/Acharya/Pradhan Acharya etc.
35. Out of State service for pay fixation and other monetary benefits shall be considered as per the rules and approval of the Government of Gujarat.
36. Call letters for attending interview will be sent to the short-listed candidates only. Candidates are advised to visit the website – www.sbvbedcollege.org basis for any update regarding to the recruitment process. In case on non-receipt of Call Letter to the short-listed candidates, website update will be considered as final.
37. No Correspondence will be entertained with applicants who are not short-listed to be called for personal interview.
38. Candidates already in service must submit a ‘No Objection Certificate (NOC) from their present employer and send/submit his /her applications (hardcopy) application duly forwarded through proper channel. In case the applicants are in service and delay is expected in getting endorsement of the employer concerned on the original application, the applicants may submit an advance copy of the application along with all enclosures directly (with or without the employer’s endorsement on the advance copy). If the original application through proper channel has not been received by the university by the last date mentioned in this employment notification, the applicants will have to submit a ‘NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE’ from his/her employer to the university at the time of personal interview.
39. Candidates, who have obtained degrees or diplomas or Certificates for various Courses / Academic Programs from any institution declared fake/derecognized by the University Grants Commission, New Delhi shall not be eligible for being considered for recruitment to the posts advertised.
40. Errors and omissions in Notification and Selection Process are subject to corrections as per the rules and regulations of UGC, New Delhi; MHRD, New Delhi, Government of Gujarat as amended from time to time.
41. Incomplete application in any respects shall not be considered/entertained and shall be summarily rejected.
