## Qualifications and General Instructions

### ❖ Assistant Professor :-

1. Acharya/Master's Degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in Sanskrit or concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent.
2. Postgraduate degree in Education (M.Ed.) with minimum 55% marks.
3. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidates must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET. Provided further, the award of degree to candidates registered for the Ph.D. programmer prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bylaws/Regulations of the Institutions awarding the degree and the Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant professor or equivalent positions in Universities/College/Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

(a) Ph.D. degree of the candidate awarded in regular mode only;

(b) Evaluation of the Ph.D. thesis by at least two external examiners;

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- (c) Open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate had been conducted;
  - (d) Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work out of which at least one must be in a refereed journal;
  - (e) Candidate has made at least two presentations in conferences/seminars, based on his/her Ph.D. work.

**Note :-** (a) to (e) as above are to be certified by the Vice-Chancellor/Pro-vice-Chancellor/Dean (Academic Affairs)/ Dean (University instructions).

## ❖ **Principal (Head) :-**

- (i) Postgraduate degree with minimum 55% marks in the discipline relevant to the area of specialization.
- (ii) Postgraduate degree in Education (M.Ed.) with minimum 55% marks.
- (iii) Ph.D. degree in Education or in the discipline relevant to the area of specialization.
- (iv) An eminent scholar with published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with a minimum of 10 publications as books and/or research /policy papers.
- (v) At least 10 years of teaching experience in University Department of Education or College of Education of which a minimum of five years at the M.Ed. level with published with in the area of specialization.
- (vi) As per NCTE norms, benefits under CAS shall be as per UGC Regulations issued from time and adopted by the University.

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
